7. All Around Open points for both men and women's events are Bareback, Saddle Bronc, Bull Riding, Calf Roping, Chute Doggin, Ribbon Roping, Team Roping, Barrels, Poles, Breakaway Roping, and Goat Tying. Awards will be given to high point winner in Women's and Men's Open division.
